1. What is the underlying attitude we are to have as we live under the Lord's yoke from verses 25-29? See 2 Chronicles 33:12; Job 42:5-6; Luke 15:18-19; 18:13.
2. What further ways can we show that same heart response to the Lord according to verse 30?
3. What is the hope of every tried and troubled believer when they respond with humility and submission to the Lord's workings in their lives? See verses 31-33.
4. What conditional statement (uses *if* or *though*) is listed in verses 31-33?
5. What promises are given in those same verses?
6. All right, let's back up a bit and see what we have so far. Are there circumstances in your life in which you have felt just like Jeremiah from verses 1-18?
7. Has your soul been bowed down under the weight of these trials and difficulties (verses 19-20)?
8. Have you been trying to think on the truths found in verses 21-24?
9. Have you been waiting, trusting, and looking for the Lord to rescue and help you as described in verses 25-30?
10. If those things are true of you, then what encouragements can you glean *for yourself* from verses 31-33?
